Habitat for Humanity of Chester County is proud to host the Eleventh Annual Build A House...Build A Dream! Contest for Kids.

About the Event

Now in its twelfth year, the contest raises both awareness of the need for affordable housing and funds for local Habitat homebuilding programs for low income families in Chester County.

Participating 5th grade students work individually or in teams to build their own three dimensional, model "dream homes" and bring them to the Contest for display and judging. Their imaginative, colorful designs reflect their far ranging interests and the issues that concern them. For example, students have created model houses designed to withstand tsunamis, houses based on spaceships and bongo drums, houses made entirely of pencils and pasta, energy efficient houses, and environmentally friendly "green" homes. All children receive recognition for their efforts and the top winners earn small cash prizes.

Since 2002, more than 5000 fifth grade students representing some 750 schools throughout the Delaware Valley have participated, and the contest has raised over \$543,000 to help support Habitat's regional homebuilding initiatives. Last year, over 700 kids and family members participated. And in addition more than 150 adult volunteers...architects, engineers, builders, designers and related professionals... served as Contest Judges and event volunteers.

About Habitat for Humanity of Chester County

HfHCC's program serves those who would not be able to afford a mortgage by conventional means. Each home is sold to a low-income family using an HfHCC no-interest 30-year mortgage for the full purchase price of the home. Habitat homeowners are carefully selected based upon three criteria: the need for decent, affordable housing; the ability to repay the mortgage loan; and the willingness to partner with Habitat by participating in our sweat equity program. We require 200 to 400 hours of sweat equity from our applicant families as part of their eligibility for Habitat homeownership.

Since 1989, volunteers have built or renovated 126 homes for low-income families in need of decent, affordable housing. (*over for more information*)

More than 85% of all non-designated cash donations are used for home construction. Mortgage payments made to HfHCC go back towards the construction or rehabilitation of homes for other other low-income families in need.

The event itself has generated a capacity attendance each year, and receives substantial media coverage, both print and broadcast, from various regional and local outlets.
